Copies of the AGM 2014 minutes were handed out amongst the Members and PH asked for approval of the minutes and signed them in accordance with the Constitution.

John Rudling took to the stage and presented the Membership Report to the audience.

Membership have waived the joining fee that was put in place – this makes for easier administration New members now receive a Membership Welcome Pack – with advice about AMPS business and useful tips

John then thanked everyone that has helped him move in to the Membership Secretary role since Pat stood down. Thanks to Sandy, Shelly and Pat

Treasurers Report – full report can be found on the AMPS website

Colin Broad took to the stage and presented the Treasury report to the audience

Colin advised on an abnormality in the report (UK Screen have taken our subscription several times this year). This is to be rectified with a refund from UK Screen

The accounts show a slight loss this year, due to changes within the Association. The Administrator, Shelly, has been an additional cost but, within the past months, her employment has proved to have helped AMPS run more smoothly and efficiently. This is seen as a positive move.

The plan is to keep Membership subscription the same for the next 1-2 years. The Treasurer is anticipating the funds held on account will drop slightly but not so much that we would be unable to continue. Once the fund balance drops to approx. £10k Council will consider increasing the subscription by an appropriate amount. Costs for this year include the redesign and relaunch of the new website. If you wish to have a look at the full details please contact Colin directly who will be happy to send you a copy of the file. The Treasurer is currently investigating a new accounting package as currently all details are kept on an excel file. Colin will have more to report at the next AGM.

Chairman's Report

Peter started his report saying that this past year has been very busy for Council with the number of changes and Shelly coming on board. Hopefully it is now settling down and starting to run smoothly and as it has been a turbulent few months he expressed his thanks to the current Council Members.

An EGM was held in October due to a requirement to update the Constitution.

One amendment was to limit the number of terms that a Council Member could serve. This was to encourage new members to consider standing for Council in order to introduce fresh thinking and ideas to Council. The amendment was passed and to conform with the new Rule Peter Hodges and Simon Bishop will stand down as of this AGM.

Peter thanked Simon for all his hard work and time served on the AMPS council. He also thanked Brian Hickin, ex Administration Secretary for his hard work and loyalty to AMPS and wished him well in his new home down in Brighton. Brian and Shelly worked hard to complete a full hand over and it brought home to us all how much Brian had contributed to the Association over many years.

A final thank you went to Sandy MacRae for all the hard work and effort he puts into the maintenance of all the AMPS email Groups/Notifications etc. Over Christmas there was an issue with the Emailing System and Sandy worried tirelessly during the holiday period to resolve the problem

Late last year Council came to the conclusion that the current Website was no longer meeting AMPS requirements and it was decided that we look for a new designer. Matthew Gough kindly helped with this search and work is ongoing in the background to create new AMPS website.

Over the last 12 months we have been publishing an electronic newsletter, which has been very favourably received and our thanks go to Tony Andrews, our editor, for compiling great content and interesting articles each month. We look forward to working with Tony on these newsletters and other AMPS requirements in the future.

We also issued two printed journals in 2014 and we are actively working with Tony and others to create a journal for later in 2015. Peter requested of the membership that if anyone has any articles or interesting tip/tricks or pictures they feel would be suitable for the Journal to please contact either Admin or Tony directly as he is always grateful to receive any material

AMPS has been collecting donations for this year's charity "Hearing Dogs for the Deaf".

This charity was the first that AMPS chose to support many years ago at the suggestion made by a previous Chairman of our Association, the late Tim Blackham A year ago AMPS was very sad to learn that Tim's widow, Hilary, had passed away. As an Honorary Member she was a wonderful asset to AMPS and will be sadly missed at the Pinewood screenings where she generously ran the raffle. Upon this sad loss her friends Meg and David Theakston, kindly came forward to offer their help to run the raffles to ensure that collecting for our charity could still continue.

The MPC Screening Theatre is unfortunately no longer accessible but Anna Sulley has managed to secure screenings at Warner Brothers De lane Lea in Soho, which, hopefully, will become a more used venue.

There were several amendments made to the Constitution at the EGM held in Oct 2014 Members of Council can now only serve a maximum of two consecutive terms allowing for at least a year to elapse before further eligibility.

Council can now conduct AMPS business, voting procedures and elections utilising whatever current and future methods of communication it deems appropriate, including paper and electronic formats.

AMPS 25th Celebration took place on the 25th October at the Cinema Museum – this was a great event and attendance was high. It was also a great opportunity to present the first AMPS Award to Chris Munro at the event. Two further awards were given to Brian Hickin and Pat Heigham for their long service to AMPS
