

GRAHAM V. HARTSTONE *AMPS*

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Born: June 1944. London, England.
Educated at Frays College, Slough Technical School, Slough College of Further Education.

Started at Pinewood Studios in August 1961 as a Sound Assistant. Progressed through Transfer, Sound Camera Operating, and Boom Operating. Worked on such pictures as '**The Moonspinners**', '**Those Magnificent Men in Their Flying Machines**', '**The Quiller Memorandum**' '**Chitty, Chitty, Bang, Bang**', many of the '**Carry On**' series and most of the '**James Bond**' films, among a host of others.

In 1969, moved into the Dubbing Theatre as an Assistant Dubbing Mixer. First credit as Chief Dubbing Mixer:- '**Blade Runner**' for Ridley Scott.

Appointed Head of Post Production for Pinewood Studios in 1988.

Took early retirement October 2005.

2005 – 2007 Sound Consultant to Pinewood Studios.

2007 – Masterclass at the School of Sound Seminar at the NFT, London.

Guest speaker at the Bradford Film Festival.

Guest Tutor at Den Norske Filmskolen, Norway.

Tutored and lectured at The National Film School of Denmark.

Lectured at Resonanssi 'When Sound Meets the Image' for the Finnish Film School and the Art Council of Pirkanmaa, Tampere, Finland.

2016 – Tutored and lectured at The National Film School of Denmark.

Currently part time Sound Tutor at the NFTS Beaconsfield, UK.

Elected a Fellow of the BKSTS. in 1992, and received the Charles Parkhouse Award in 1998.

Awarded a Fellowship of the Association of Motion Picture Sound (AMPS.) in 1999.

Member of The Academy of Motion Picture Arts and Sciences since 1979

Awarded Life Membership of BAFTA in 2008
